CONTEST GUIDELINES

10th Ever BassAckwards Poker Run

3:00PM – 6:00PM
Saturday July 18, 2026

The BassAckwards Poker Run is a small vessel rally that travels to 5 different locations around Red Brook and Pocasset Harbors to pick up playing cards at each stop. At the end of the event the 5 cards are turned in and the best five-card standard poker hand wins. **This is not a race. Participants travel at their own speed. There is no benefit to being "first" to any of the card stops.**

THE GAME

The game is open to any power, sail or paddle vessel. Boat captains should pick up their entry flags at the Kingman dock house before leaving to play. They may leave at any time after 3:00PM on Saturday and travel to each of 5 destinations during the afternoon. Dealer boats at destinations will be flying checkered flags to identify themselves to players. Destinations may be visited in any order. A playing card will be passed to the boat in a sealed envelope at each stop.

Dealers will leave their destinations at 6:00PM, so participants should plan on completing their travels before then. Participants should bring their five-card hand to the Kingman Yacht Club at 7:00PM Saturday evening.

Participants will have the opportunity to purchase two additional cards per boat at the Draw Party. In order to preserve the natural odds of a poker game, a boat will be dealt cards from the same deck throughout the event, with no more than 7 boats sharing the same deck of playing cards. **We will deal from 5 decks, with a maximum of 35 boats participating.** To ensure that you get a card from the same deck at each stop, your boat will be assigned and display a colored flag, and the dealers will pass cards that conform to the deck for each color.

AWARDS

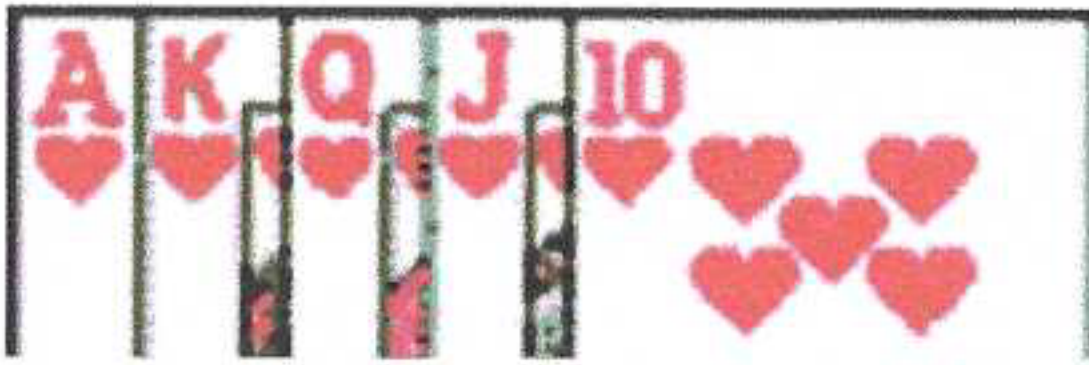
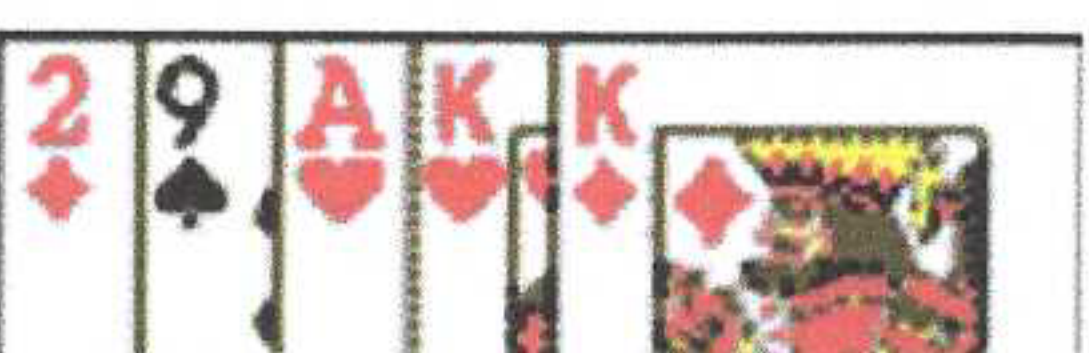
Captains will present their 5-card hands at the Draw Party at 7:00PM on Saturday 7/18. There will be a cash bar at the Draw Party. The boat with the best hand will win \$1,000. The boat with the worst poker hand will win \$500.

RULES

Participants must not open their sealed card envelopes until the drawing at the awards party! Envelopes which are opened or show evidence of tampering will result in disqualification of the boat.

This is NOT a race, and at no time during the poker run will racing occur between/among participants.

Every boat must comply with current USCG safety requirements, carry on board the required USCG safety equipment, and operate in a safe manner in accordance with all applicable regulations.

Poker Hand	Example
Royal Flush Ace, King, Queen, Jack and Ten from the same suit	
Straight Flush Five cards in consecutive order from the same suit	
Four Of A Kind Four cards from different suits of the same rank	
Full House Three of a kind and a pair	
Flush Five cards of same suit	
Straight Five cards in consecutive order, any combination of suits	
Three Of A Kind Three cards from different suits displaying the same number or picture	
Two Pair Two groups of two cards showing the same number (or picture)	
Pair One pair of identically ranked cards	
Nothing/High Card Where there is non of the above are present the highest card of your hand is taken. (ranked highest to lowest A, K, Q, J, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2)	

2026 BassAckwards POKER RUN DEALER STOPS

Stops will be manned by volunteers flying red and blue “racing” flags from 3:00PM until 6:00PM.
Stops may be visited in any order during that time.

Participating boats should approach the dealer boats at idle speed and display their boat’s color.
